Free summer meals, funded by the USDA, are available to kids and teens ages 18 and younger at summer meal sites in the Concord School District.

Meals are available at the following sites and times listed:

Concord High school – Breakfast Only – June 5 through June 23rd from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.

Concord South Side Elementary – Tuesdays and Wednesdays – June 6-7, 13-14, 20-21, July 11-12, 18-19.

Breakfast from 9:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and Lunch from 12:30 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Concord Jr. High School – Breakfast Only – August 2 through August 11 from 9:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

Concord East Side, Concord Ox Bow, Concord South Side, & Concord West Side –Breakfast Only – August 7 through August 10 from 9:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Free Summer Meal Program Details:

- Meals are FREE to children and teens ages 18 and younger who come to a summer meal site
- Free summer meals will help families save money and stretch their already tight food budgets
- Food served is healthy and follows USDA nutrition guidelines
- No application or proof of income needed. You can just bring your child to a summer meal site
